Attendance is very important! If your child misses school, please remember to write a note or call the office telling why your child was absent. The attendance line number is (519) 570-8087, extension 3384. Arrival - School begins at 9:20am. Students must wait quietly outside the school, at the bottom door by the kindergarten playground until that time and will be greeted promptly by the supervising teacher.

An adult must accompany the children until they are greeted.


Your child will need a zippered **Backpack** big enough to hold a Library Book, a Lunch Bag, extra clothes and possibly a pair of boots. Always check your child's **B**ag everyday! Your child's mailbag will be in the bag every night. Every child's **B**irthday is important. Please contact us if you'd like to send in a special snack. We will recognize summer birthdays at the end of the school year. We will send home **Book order** forms for you and your child to look over every month. Book clubs offer books at reduced prices. It's a great way to build your child's home library!

Communication is very important. Feel free to contact me whenever you have a question, comment, or concern. You can reach me by phone (519-621-9981), in person, or by note in the Communication Book. You will receive a school Calendar every month to let you know what's happening.

Dismissal - 3:40pm. Children will only be released to an adult we have registered. Your child will not be released to anyone who is not on the list without your permission. You must come down to the Kindergarten entrance to pick up your child. A teacher will escort bus students to the bus at dismissal time. Your child's safety is our number one concern!

Please help your child learn to **Enter** and **Exit** the building safely. Students should always be escorted by a grown-up when crossing the parking lot.

We will be going on **Field trips**. We always like for parents to go with us, but younger siblings cannot go along. Information about **field trips** will come home in the mailbag and will be detailed in the field trip permission slip and monthly newsletter. Sign up on <u>school-day.com</u>.

It is Important to keep all records current. If you move, get a new phone number, or change babysitters, please be sure to inform the school. Also, don't forget to send the Important Paper envelope back to school within the first week of school! Independence is a goal for students because it builds self-esteem and self-confidence. Kindies are very capable of doing many things on their own and we encourage them to do as much as they can for themselves in the classroom. Please work on the following self-help skills at home with your child: zipping, tying, dressing, etc.

Don't forget to \mathbf{J} oin Parent Council! Parent participation is important and valued.

The Keys to a successful school year include good communication between home and school, a positive attitude and good attendance. Keep updated by reading the classroom newsletter every month and checking the mailbag every day for other notes and information. Donations of Kleenex are always appreciated! Kiss and Ride is a service all students can use coming and going from school. Watch for information in the Highland newsletters.

We will be checking out **Library** books twice each week. Our class eats **Lunch** at 11:00am and 1:45pm. Please read the Healthy Eating For the Balanced School Day information. Remember you will need to pack enough food for two separate eating times.

Money is difficult for a child to keep track of. Please send in any money in a sealed, labeled envelope.

Not feeling well. If your child has a fever or has been sick the night before, please do not send him/her to school. Always sign your child in and out of the Office when picking him/her up or dropping off. Please be prompt when picking your child up. A Newsletter will be sent home each month to keep you informed about what is happening in our class.

We will have **Outdoor play** every day. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. Please consider applying **Sunscreen** on your child ever morning.

Please make sure that we have your current **Phone number** at home and at work. We also need a number of a trusted friend or family member to call if we cannot reach you. It's important that we be able to reach you in case of an emergency.

Reading is very important. Please read to your child as often as possible. Don't forget to fill out your child's SPIKE (Reading at Home) reading log after every book read. Report Cards will be sent home twice a year (Once at the end of the Fall/Winter semester, and at the end of the Spring/Summer semester).

Our system for **Self-regulation** is simple. We work hard to make the classroom a positive and safe place for all. Rules are agreed upon during the first week of school and read and discussed daily. Problems are looked upon as just that--problems to be solved. Your child must have a pair of indoor **Shoes** that can be left at school. We recommend running shoes (NO LACES PLEASE) for daily use. Please label your child's shoes. **S**chool-Day.com is a website our school uses to inform families about Field trips and special events as well as collect permission forms and money. Once you receive the information to sign-up, please do so. **S**pike home reading program will run October until May. Your child will bring home an early reader book they should practice to read independently. Your child can change the book everyday.

Toys - Your child should not bring toys to school. If your child is required to bring in an item for an educational activity, you will be notified in writing. Your child is important to us! We will always treat your child with lots of love, respect, and Understanding!!

We love parent **Volunteers**. If you have some time to offer--either in the classroom or at home, please fill out and return the parent volunteer form. Help is always needed and appreciated. If you aren't able to come for any reason, please give as much notice as possible. You must always sign in at the office and get a **Visitor's pass**. Strangers in the school cause concern and will be asked to report to the office. Remember, --not everyone knows you.

Have your child **Wear practical clothes** to school. We will make every effort to protect your child's clothes. Also, please label all jackets, sweaters, backpacks, and lunch pails with permanent ink.

We need to have extra clothes at school if your child has an accident, or gets wet, etc. Please send your child with a labeled Ziploc bag, which will be stored at school.

Please remember that **You** are your child's first and most important teacher. No one can influence your child's life in the way that you can! **Your ideas...and** suggestions are welcome!
