<b>October</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• learning letters, looking at our Chicka Chicka Boom Boom Exchange Letters</li><li>• learning about how to be a good friend (ongoing)</li><li>• using our manners and being nice to each other and offering to help others</li><li>• learning about the Fall season and why the leaves change colours</li><li>• using leaves and crayons at the creative centre and making rubbings</li><li>• learning about sorting in math and coming up with different sorting rules when sorting toys. E.g. sorting the animals by colour, sorting the vehicles by size, sorting the toys by shape</li><li>• Learning good authors add more letters, words and pictures to their stories.</li><li>• What's new with the Toronto Blue Jays? 😊</li></ul>
