This week in 6A Students:

- * Superstars are really enjoying our counting and place value unit.
- *We have been counting forwards and backwards by various amounts in a hundreds chart
- *Students have been representing various 3 digit numbers as well as identifying the numbers of ones, tens and hundreds for other numbers.
- *Students practiced logging into their mPower accounts.
- *In Science, we watched a video on the parts of a plant and a slideshow. Students created their own Google Slides on the parts of a plant
- *We completed a stem experiment by placing celery and flowers into jars of water mixed with food colouring.
- *Students are really enjoying adding the finishing touches on their About Me slideshow
- *We participated in the Terry Fox assembly.
- *As a class we brainstormed things to remember when presenting.
- *Superstars added to a point, proof, comment graphic organizer to identify the main idea and a few supporting details. in "It's Okay to Be Different" and Going Places"
- *Students used a graphic organizer to generate ideas for a recount on a summer activity
- *Superstars created a poster of a motivational saying that is important to them.
- *We exchanged library books
- *Students are enjoying our Outdoor Activity Time. Some favourite games this week were: Tide in, Tide Out, Lion's Den and relay races.
