This week in 6A Students:

*Superstars completed a main idea response to the story "Chrysanthemum".

*We also read the story "Those Shoes" trying to expand on examples already given

*Students continued to work on their recounts

*Superstars helped Mr. Heer expand on his ideas from his recount on "Going to the Brantford Zoo" *In Math we practiced rounding numbers to the nearest hundred and ten

*We also practiced building a number lines with scale

*Superstars completed a place value check-in where they represented numbers multiple ways and in expanded form.

*Students had a rounding numbers quiz.

*In Science, we brainstormed plant products. We discussed items made from: wood, cotton, latex/rubber.

*Superstars learned about processed and unprocessed foods. We talked about how some foods become more processed than others. We brainstormed products that come from apples, discussing which ones were more processed than others.

*In Art, we brainstormed different types of lines before learning how to draw block letters. We began a cool name Art piece.

*Mr. Heer continued to read with students to find their correct reading levels.

*We did a making words activity.

Next week we will:

*Begin a patterning unit

*Continue with our recount writing and point of view

*Begin talking about plant survival tactics
