#### Language Arts

We finished our research projects and presented the information using our knowledge of non-fiction text features. They turned out amazingly and we learned so much about how others live around the world. We have continued to practise writing different poetic forms such as hyperboles, and finished our Underground Railroad poster showing some of the stops that black slaves had to make in their journey to freedom in the North.

### Mathematics

We read a book called <u>A Remainder of One</u> where we discovered that when we share items equally into groups, we are dividing. We practised solving problems involving subtraction sentences. We also discovered that multiplication and division are related and that if we know a multiplication fact, then we also know its related division fact.

#### Science

We learned that machines have been invented to make our life easier and that simple machines can be found all around us (e.g., levers, screws, wedges, inclined planes, etc.).
